Our Education Mission team is in Haiti for two weeks. They are partnering with 5 schools to encourage teacher development and improve learning opportunities for Haitian children. Our team was warmly received by Pastor Desipin Cherebin, who has newly been elected senator. Let's keep this team in our prayers!

Our team is providing seminars for teachers to learn about Bloom's Taxonomy, a way to promote higher forms of thinking in education, such as analyzing and evaluating concepts, processes, procedures, and principles, rather than just remembering facts (rote learning).

Cormie Jordan-Hass spoke with 27 seminary students at Hosanna Seminary. The large room has only one light bulb, but God's light shone through! A successful night!
