Please join us in welcoming Melissa to VPC!

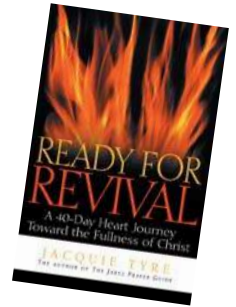
