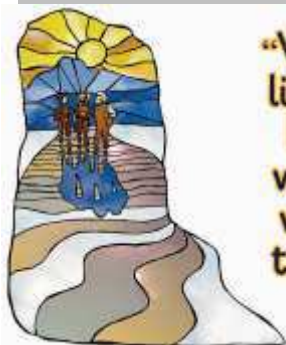

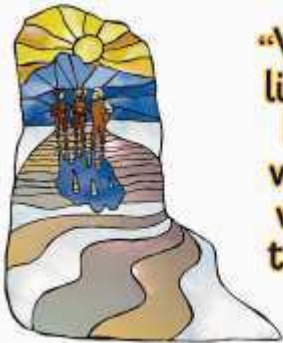

Fall Opportunities for All Ages Begins September 11

Children & Student Opportunities:

What's New—We heard your feedback and made these changes:

- All K-12th grade choirs practice at the 11am hour.
- 4th-6th grades begin in worship and then are excused to Sunday school during the 9:30 service. Sunday school meets the full hour at 11am.
- 7th-12th grade Sunday school classes return to the 9:30 hour.
- There will be no Sunday school for 4th-12th grades on communion Sundays, so children can participate in worship and communion with the church body.
- A mixed-aged class will be offered at 11am for 4th grade through adults. The curriculum is gospel-centered and accessible to everyone!

Why make these changes?

- To simplify the morning schedule for families.
- To encourage families to worship together: Studies show that children and youth who attend worship are more likely to retain their faith when they graduate.
- Mixed-aged classes are a great way for children and students to get to know other adults in the congregation and have conversations about faith. Parents can participate in the class and continue the Sunday morning conversations at home all week.
