Join us for our free estate-planning seminar on May 17, at 7:00pm or May 18, at 9:00am. You will learn more about

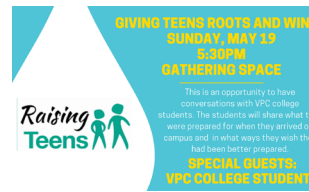
