Everyone Needs a Will or Living Trust!



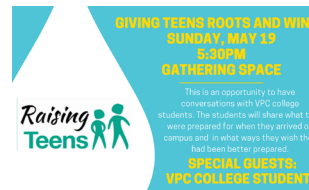
Join us for our free estate planning seminar on May 17, at 7:00pm or May 18, at 9:00am. You will learn

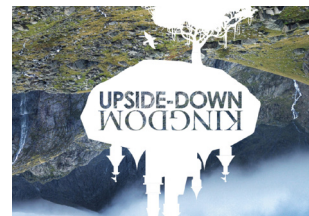
Cathedral Brass Spring Concert
